Directions For Use

Application Instructions

Follow the application rates and timings for weed sizes as specified on the **Poast® herbicide** label. Follow the spray volume and pressure recommendations as described on the **Poast** label. For crop-specific restrictions and limitations, consult **Table 1** below. **Poast** does not control sedges or broadleaf weeds. Apply **Poast** at 0.5-1.5 pints per acre to actively grow-

ing annual and perennial grasses. For perennial grass control, make a subsequent application of **Poast** or cultivate 7-14 days after an initial or any subsequent application to improve control. Use additives according to the **Spray Additives** section of this label.

Apply **Poast** to the foliage of grasses on a spray-to-wet basis uniformly and completely because large leaf canopies shelter smaller grass weeds and can prevent adequate spray coverage. Adjust the boom height or use drop nozzles to ensure thorough coverage of the grass weeds. Do not spray to the point of runoff.

Do not apply to drought-stressed grass or grass which has gone through an extended dry period. In irrigated areas, irrigate prior to applications of **Poast** to ensure weeds are actively growing.

Spray Additives

Always use use crop oil concentrate or methylated seed oil at 1.0 - 2.0 pints per acre. Also refer to the respective additive labels for specific recommendations.
