It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in formulating soil fumigants and technical microbiocides. This product is not to be used to formulate products designed for use in once-through cooling systems.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE:

Store this product in a dry, cool place below 95 degrees Fahrenheit. Material reacts nonviolently with moisture, releasing fumigant vapors. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not re-use empty container. Keep this product and its vapors away from desirable plants, seeds, fertilizers, insecticides and other agricultural chemicals, as plant injury or loss may result from contamination.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Fiber (Box) Drum - Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, if allowed by state and local authorities. If (box) drum is contaminated and cannot be re-used, dispose of in the same manner.

Paper Bag - Completely empty bag into application equipment. The
