4. Also find enclosed a copy of the Metam Sodium Task Force's October 16, 1985 proposal in response to the September 28, 1984 Metam Sodium Data Call-In Notice (of which you are a member).

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

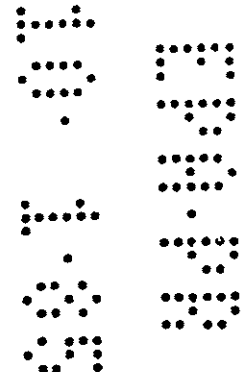
