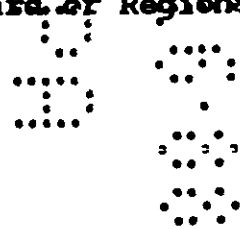
If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

Storage and Disposal
