Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

The finished formulations of Mecoprop-P-containing herbicidal products must be prepared only with suitable solvents, emulsifiers and wetting agents which are exempt from requirements of tolerance under the Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act.

Do not allow this chemical or dilutions of it to come into contact with sensitive crop plants, trees, or ornamentals.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Do not store near other pesticides, fertilizers, or seeds. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

Pesticide Disposal: Thoroughly clean equipment before using for other purposes. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not contaminate water
