## Frontier 6.0° Herbicide Fall Application Use Programs

Frontier 6.0 may be used in a fall application for weed control in minimum-tillage or no-tillage corn or soybean production systems planted the following spring. Applications of 32 fluid ounces per acre may be made to medium- and fine-textured soils with greater than 2.5% organic matter. Fall applications must be made after October 1. Apply Frontier 6.0 in the fall after crop harvest when soil temperatures at the 4" depth are sustained at less than 55° F and before the ground freezes. Tillage operations may be conducted before or after applying Frontier 6.0. If following an application, tillage should be no more than 2-3" deep to uniformly incorporate the herbicide into the upper soil surface.

If a sequential application program (fall application followed by spring application of Frontier 6.0) is used, the maximum combined rate of Frontier 6.0 that may be is applied is 32 fluid ounces per acre per crop season.
