Before applying **Distinct** to popcorn, verify the selectivity of **Distinct** on the popcorn hybrid with your local seed corn company (supplier). This precaution will help avoid potential injury of sensitive lines.

Application Rates and Timings

Distinct can be applied up to 14 days before planting corn using rates of 4-6 ounces per acre. When planting into a legume sod (e.g., alfalfa or clover), apply 6-8 ounces of **Distinct** per acre after 4-6" of regrowth. Allow at least 21 days before planting if using more than 6 ounces per acre. Adjuvants must be used with **Distinct** to achieve consistent weed control.

When using liquid fertilizer as the carrier, always pre-slurry **Distinct** in water to fertilizer solutions. Add the
