Your Amended Application Dated September 6, 2000

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following comments listed below.

1. Revise the "Statement of Practical Treatment" subheading and "First Aid" statement to read as follows:

#### **FIRST AID**

"IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

**"IF ON SKIN:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

"IF SWALLOWED: Call Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by a Poison Control Center or doctor.

Storage: Store this product in a dry, cool place below 95°F; it will decompose at higher temperatures. Material reacts nonviolently with moisture or accelerants, releasing fumigant vapors. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Triple-rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by state authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. Do not reuse empty container.

### Wood and Wood Products

BASAMID Pellets is recommended for the internal remedial treatment and protection of wood products such as utility poles, pilings timbers and other large solid or laminated wood products against fungal decay. BASAMID Pellets is not to be used indoors or underneath indoor structures.

BASAMID Pellets is designed to be placed inside the wood product to be treated. The total amount applied will be dependent of the size of the wood unit and the zone to be protected. BASAMID Pellets is applied in treatment holes drilled into the wood at a 45° angle downward or greater, which are then plugged. For wood in ground contact, the first hole should start at or slightly below ground-line and should be arranged in a spiral pattern covering the treatment zone with about 6" to 12" vertically between holes. Do not overfill the treatment holes, to allow room for a plug.

The following example can be used as a guide for the application of this product to treat the grounding zone of a 35" circumference standing utility pole.

- 1. Drill three 7/8 inch diameter by 14 inch long holes at a steep downward angle in a spiral pattern starting at groundline as described above.
- 2. Apply 70 grams of BASAMID Pellets into each hole, using a calibrated applicator.
- 3. Add liquid accelerant if desired to treatment hole.

4. Plug the treatment hole with a tight-fitting treated wooden dowel, removable plastic plug, or other suitable cap.

An accelerant of a 1% solution of Copper Naphthenate in Mineral Spirits may be added to treatment holes after the BASAMID Pellets, and is designed to speed the decomposition and release of active fumigant inside the wood product.

Accelerating the release of fumigant is especially desirable when active decay is present. Keep accelerants away from BASAMID Pellets except in treatment holes, which should be plugged immediately after they combine.
