- d. Revise the oral statement of practical treatment to read as follows (This change is based on the product's TOX II classification for eye and skin irritation potential.):

"If swallowed: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, eggwhites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol."

- e. Correct the typographical error in the second to last sentence under "Environmental Hazards". The words "this product" should appear only once.

3. Submit data to satisfy product chemistry guidelines 830.7220 (Boiling point), 830.6315 (Flammability/Flashpoint), and 830.7100 (Viscosity) within 90 days.

4. Submit data to satisfy product chemistry guidelines 830.6317 (Storage Stability) and 830.6320 (Corrosion Characteristics) upon completion of these studies. The Agency understands that these studies are in progress.

5. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. A copy of EPA's review of product chemistry data for this product is also enclosed.

Environmental Hazards

The finished formulations of Dichlorprop-P-2EH containing herbicidal products must be prepared only with suitable solvents, emulsifiers, and wetting agents which are exempt from requirements of tolerance under the Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.

Do not allow this chemical or dilutions of it to come into contact with sensitive crop plants, trees, or ornamentals.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Do not store near other pesticides, fertilizers, or seeds. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal or cleaning of equipment.
