Dear Mr Haughey:

The master label referred to above, submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended to add sugarcane, Belgium endive, globe artichoke, persimmon, update crop groups, and separate uses between foliar and seed treatment applications is unconditionally acceptable under FIFRA section 3(c)(5). The unconditional acceptance of this amendment does not affect the current conditional registration of the active ingredient.

The Agency has determined that the subject Immunotoxicity data are acceptable and satisfy the guideline requirements 870.7800.

As per the Agency's Environmental Risk Assessment, if you plan to submit new uses for this active ingredient, an upgraded chronic fish study is requested to further characterize the possible risk.
