Supplemental Labeling for Radicchio (red chicory) per PR Notice 98-10

Reference: Active Ingredient - Boscalid (EPA Reg. No. 7969-198)

This is a notification to the EPA for use of Endura® fungicide Supplemental Labeling for control of Sclerotinia on Radicchio (red chicory) in accordance with PR Notice 98-10, Section IIB, "Adding or Deleting Pests". The use of Endura for control of several diseases on Radicchio is approved under the Leafy Greens Crop Subgroup 4A on page 15 of the enclosed Endura master label. However, based on available data, BASF has decided to market Endura for control of only Sclerotinia on radicchio and the Endura supplemental labeling is needed prior to approval of the Endura container / marketing label in all the states. BASF has included a 3-year limit on the use of the Endura supplemental label after which the use on radicchio for control of Sclerotinia will be included on the Endura container / marketing label.

"This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under section 12 and 14 of FIFRA."
