Dear Dr. Akkari:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Among the approved uses are formulator seed treatment uses: brassicas, bulb vegetables, cucurbits, legume vegetables, soybean, and sunflower. Additionally, the following foliar formulating uses were approved: head and stem brassicas, leafy brassica greens, celery, cucurbit vegetables, succulent and dried peas, and pomefruits.
2. Under the section "Conditions of Sale and Warranty," revise the second and fourth sentence, appending each with the clause: "To the extent consistent with applicable law...." As currently written, the statement negates and/or detracts from labeling requirements as set forth by the Agency in 40 CFR Part 156, and is, thus considered misbranding.
