

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to birds, fish and aquatic and estuarine (tidewater dwelling) invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas.

Do not apply within 15 feet of bodies of fresh water: lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes, natural ponds, and commercial fish ponds. A 15 foot buffer of uniform groundcover must exist between application zone and borders of freshwater (uniform ground cover is defined as land which supports vegetation of greater than 2 inches throughout).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE

Store unused product in original container only, out of reach of children and animals. NEVER TRANSFER THIS PRODUCT TO ANOTHER CONTAINER FOR STORAGE.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Nonrefillable Container. DO NOT reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse or pressure rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying; then offer for recycling, if available, or reconditioning, if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Triple rinse containers small enough to shake (capacity ≤ 5 gallons) as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank, or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.


Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank, or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.

Read the entire label first. If you do not understand any parts of the label, call 1-800-832-HELP (4357). Use **H&G 61743A Fipronil Insecticide** only as described on this label.

How to use: Shake entire bottle [1 or 2 times] before using. Adjust spray to given desired pattern. Hold spray handle about 1-2 feet away from surface to spray and begin spraying. Spray **ONLY** as directed in use directions found below.

This insecticide is especially effective at very low doses, but may require 2-3 days to take maximum effect.

Application is limited to one application per year. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system. Do not apply to pastures or grazing lands.
