The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

As agreed to in your email of 9/29/06, the respirator statement in the precautionary statements must be revised as follows:

Wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C), or a NIOSH approved respirator with any N, R, P or HE filter.

The last sentence of the pesticide disposal statements must be revised as follows: Decontaminate tools and equipment following cleanup.

The large scale spillage statements under the heading "In Case of Emergency" must be incorporated into the spillage instructions under the subheading "Pesticide Disposal".

Delete the statements beginning with "In case of emergency regarding this product, call..." because they duplicate and detract from the First Aid statements.

FIRST AID.
