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b. Change the first sentence in the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" section from "Harmful if absorbed through the skin." to "Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin."

c. In the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" section, after either the sentence that reads "Causes moderate eye irritation." or the sentence that reads "Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing." add a sentence that reads "Avoid breathing dust."

3. Submit the following studies that satisfy the indicated Product Chemistry data requirements by no later than the date indicated for each study.

a. Submit an acceptable Ultraviolet/Visible Absorption study (Guideline Requirement Number (GRN) 830.7050) by no later than February 29, 2008. The Agency is aware that BASF has submitted a study (MRID No. 472208-01) intended to satisfy this requirement.

b. Submit an acceptable Dissociation Constant study (GRN 830.7370) by no later than February 29, 2008. The Agency is aware that BASF has rebutted the need for this requirement.

c. Submit an acceptable Partition Coefficient study (GRN 830.7550) by no later than February 29, 2008. The Agency is aware that BASF has presented an argument that such an acceptable study has already been submitted (MRID No. 451182-15) for the me-tooed product (EPA Reg. No. 7969-185).

4. By February 29, 2008 explain the discrepancy between the experimental value for product density (999.97 grams per liter) and the product density value (582 grams per liter) in Box 7 of the Basic Confidential Statement of formula (CSF) and, if the value on the CSF is incorrect, submit a revised Basic CSF reflecting the change for the subject product. The Agency is aware that BASF has already submitted an explanation for the two different bulk density values for the subject product, and that BASF feels that there is no need to submit a revised CSF.

< 5. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the subject product the Agency's records before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation, in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

The changes we are requiring (above) to the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section of the label result from a re-evaluation of the Acute Inhalation Toxicity study (MRID No. 454731-02; this is the second of the two Acute Inhalation Toxicity studies that were submitted by BASF in support of EPA Reg. No. 7969-185) that supports the me-tooed product (EPA Reg. No. 7969-185). This second Acute Inhalation Toxicity study received its primary review from Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) of Canada and its secondary review from U.S. EPA. At that time U.S. EPA found the endpoint value of this study to fall into Acute Inhalation Toxicity Category IV. However, during the current review the endpoint was recalculated and determined to fall into Acute

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Inhalation Toxicity Category III. This change mandated adding the above additional inhalation warning statements to the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section. Similar changes, for the same reason, will be required in the label for EPA Reg. No. 7969-185, but this will addressed in a separate letter to BASF.
