The application referred to above, submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable under FIFRA sec 3 (c)(5). A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

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Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. #### **Product Information**

**Armezon** provides systemic postemergence control or growth suppression of emerged broadleaf and grass weeds. Refer to the **Armezon** container label for a complete list of weeds controlled or suppressed and maximum weed sizes.

#### **Application Instructions**

**Armezon** is only registered for use in African marigold grown for the purpose of lutein and zeaxanthin extraction.

#### Use Method, Rate, and Timing

Apply **Armezon** in a single application or sequential applications after complete crop recovery with an interval of 14 days or more.

Apply 0.5 to 1.0 fluid ounce of **Armezon** per acre as a ground broadcast spray. Best product performance is obtained when weeds are small and actively growing. Thorough coverage of existing weeds is essential, and higher spray volume may be needed for best performance.

Armezon applications must include spray additives. The specific additive (adjuvant plus nitrogen fertilizer) requirements for application in African marigold are as follows:

• Crop oil concentrate (COC) at 1.5 gallons per 100 gallons of water (1.5% volume/volume), plus

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- Spray grade ammonium sulfate (AMS) at 8.5 pounds per 100 gallons of water or a liquid nitrogen fertilizer such as urea ammonium nitrate (UAN, 28% to 34%) or ammonium phosphate (10-34-0) at 1.25 to 2.5 gallons per 100 gallons of water (1.25% to 2.5% v/v).
- DO NOT use methylated seed oil (MSO) as a substitute for COC or severe crop injury may occur.

**Postemergence.** Apply **Armezon® herbicide** over-thetop of African marigold when target weeds are actively growing. African marigold plants must have at least 2 to 4 full leaves with a minimum height of 3 to 5 inches, before an **Armezon** application can be made.

**Postemergence-directed.** Apply **Armezon** as a postemergence-directed spray beneath the canopy of established plants and between rows for postemergence weed control.

#### **Crop-specific Restrictions**

- **DO NOT** apply more than 1.0 fluid ounce of **Armezon** (0.022 lb topramezone) per acre in a single application.
- **DO NOT** apply more than a maximum cumulative total of 2.0 fluid ounces of **Armezon** (0.044 lb topramezone) per acre per year.
- **DO NOT** graze livestock in treated fields or feed treated plant materials to animals.
- DO NOT apply by air.

- Avoid overlapping spray patterns because crop injury can occur.
- Refer to **Armezon** container label for rotational crop intervals.
