**Directions For Use**

**Fall Applications**

For use only in the following states: Iowa, Minnesota, and Wisconsin.

Integrity may be applied in the fall to control weeds in conventional, minimum tillage, or no-till corn production systems planted the following spring. Apply 13 to 16 fluid ounces of Integrity per acre to medium- and fine-textured soils with greater than 2.5% organic matter. Fall applications must be made after October 1.

For broadcast surface application, apply Integrity in the fall after crop harvest when soil temperatures at the 4 inch depth are sustained at less than 55° F and before the ground freezes. Tillage operations may be conducted before or after applying Integrity. If following an application, tillage should be no more than 2 to 3 inches deep to uniformly incorporate the herbicide into the upper soil surface. If a sequential application program (fall application followed by spring application of Integrity) is used, the maximum combined rate of Integrity that may be applied is 25 fluid ounces per acre, per crop season.
