**CanDo™ Granular Fire Ant Bait** is highly attractive to imported and native fire ants Worker ants find the bait and carry it into the mound as food for the colony The bait is eaten fed to the queen and the mound is destroyed

If consumed the entire colony will usually be controlled For faster control combine broadcast applications with individual mound treatments Combining mound and broadcast applications will control established colonies and help prevent new ones from developing To maintain freshness and attractiveness of the bait keep the container tightly sealed and use the product within 3 months of purchase

## Application Instructions

**Read the label first!**

### When to Apply

Apply at the first sign of fire ant activity. For best results apply **CanDo™ Granular Fire Ant Bait** in the early morning or late afternoon when fire ants are most active. Fire ants are most active when temperatures are above 60 °F. **CanDo Granular Fire Ant Bait** can control fire ants up to 8 weeks depending on environmental conditions.

### Before you Apply

**DO NOT** apply when the ground is saturated with water, heavy dew, or when heavy rains are expected within 12 hours.

- Rainfall within 12 hours of application can reduce the effectiveness of **CanDo Granular Fire Ant Bait**. A repeat application may be necessary to achieve desired level of control.

### How to Apply to Mounds

**DO NOT** disturb the mound.

- **DO NOT** apply directly onto the mound.
- **RATE** Apply 1 to 2 ozs (2 to 4 level tablespoons) of **CanDo Granular Fire Ant Bait** per mound, uniformly distribute the bait 3 to 4 feet around the mound perimeter. **DO NOT** use kitchen utensils for measuring.
- **DO NOT** water in granules after application. Wait at least 12 hours after application before irrigating treated area.
- Retreat after 4 to 8 weeks, if needed.
- **DO NOT** exceed 4 applications per year.

### How to Apply Broadcast Treatments for Large Infested Areas (including lawns)

- Use a hand held or walk behind spreader to apply.
- **RATE** Apply 2 to 3 ozs per 5,000 sq ft (1 to 1.5 lbs/A) (1 acre = 43,560 sq ft).
- Calculate the area of the lawn to be treated and use the **Suggested Spreader Settings for Broadcast Application** chart to make application.
- For best results, allow 7 days before the use of another contact insecticide product on the bait treated area.
- Retreat after 4 to 8 weeks, if needed.
- **DO NOT** exceed 4 applications per year (6 lbs/A).
