General Classification

Read entire label and use strictly in accordance with label cautions, warnings and directions. It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. After use, wrap container and put in trash collection.

IMPORTANT FOR PROPER USE

Use one can for each 6,000 cubic feet (up to 30' x 25' x 8') of unobstructed area. Use additional units for rooms, areas or where free flow of air is not assured.

This product will kill Fleas, Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Ticks, Spiders, Vets and Small Flying Moths.

Acts in control of Roaches.

Place can in center of area to be fogged. Unfold several layers of newspaper and press can in middle of paper on floor. Open cardboard and store in area to be treated and fogged. REMOVE PETS. Cover fan areas or electric and gas outlets. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Put out all open flames and lights. Close doors and windows. Keep all areas fogged when recommended can empty from two hours minimum.

Use Thats: Destroy all pet bedding and replace. Use product to clean treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.

To Kill Fleas: Follow directions for ticks but use one unit per 1,500 cubic feet of room space.

Heavy fog collection may occur. Use repeat fogging in 6-10 days to kill newly hatched flea or mosquito. Repeat fogging for ticks may also be necessary.

TO STAY FOGGING: Push down securely on valve actuator and force valve into locked position. Place can in upright position in middle of room. Fogging and fumes will fill area. Leave unobstructed for at least four hours. Then open doors and windows and allow to air for 24 hours.

CAUTION:
