Directions For Use: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling. This product is for residential use.

To Operate: Shake can before using. Hold container upright. Point valve opening away from face and press button.

INDOORS

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, and trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles, Ticks, Fleas and Flea larvae: Spray top and underside of rugs. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS

To Reduce Annoyance Of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats And Small Flying Moths: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at a rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Ornamental Plant Pests Listed Below:

General: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants. WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT.

To Kill Ornamental Plant Pests Listed Below (continued):

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of a row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.
