### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is for residential use.

To operate: Shake can before using. Hold container upside down. Point valve away from body and press button.



### TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS

Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and floors. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pets' quarters after spray has dried. Treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area. Pay particular attention to areas where pets congregate. To treat carpets, spray at the rate of one square foot per second. Repeat treatment as necessary.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air if effects occur, and call a physician.

IF SWALLOWED: Get immediate medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash can.
