DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This paint is sold for use ONLY on ship and boat bottoms for the prevention of marine fouling. Do not use it in any household application.

Previously painted bottoms on which old paint is in good condition and firmly attached may be recoated after sanding off all loose dirt. Paint any small bare spots before proceeding to do entire bottom. Where old paint is loose and flaking in large areas, strip it off and proceed as for new unpainted work.

No primer is required for previously unpainted wood bottoms. Previously unpainted fiberglass bottoms should be dewaxed and primed with one coat of 8370 (2 part) or 375 (1 part) Epoxy Fiberglass Primer. Previously unpainted steel should be primed with 407 Shipbottom Primer, and aluminum with 410 Q.D. Green

Primer, in accordance with the directions for use of these materials.

Before using copper paint, it must be mixed thoroughly. This is best accomplished by pouring from one container to another until paint is uniform, or by machine agitation. Apply 2 coats to clean, dry surface, allowing at least 4 hours between coats and before launching. Reasonable additional drying time before launching will not interfere with the antifouling properties of this paint.

Thin only if absolutely necessary to restore free-brushing consistency. Use paint thinner or turpentine well stirred in for this purpose and for cleaning brushes and equipment. Adder and water.

CAUTION - FLAMMABLE

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

This paint contains copper and other compounds. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist and contact with skin. Wash immediately with soap and water in case of skin contact. Use protective mask to prevent contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

Keep container closed when not in use. Keep out of reach of children. USE WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION.

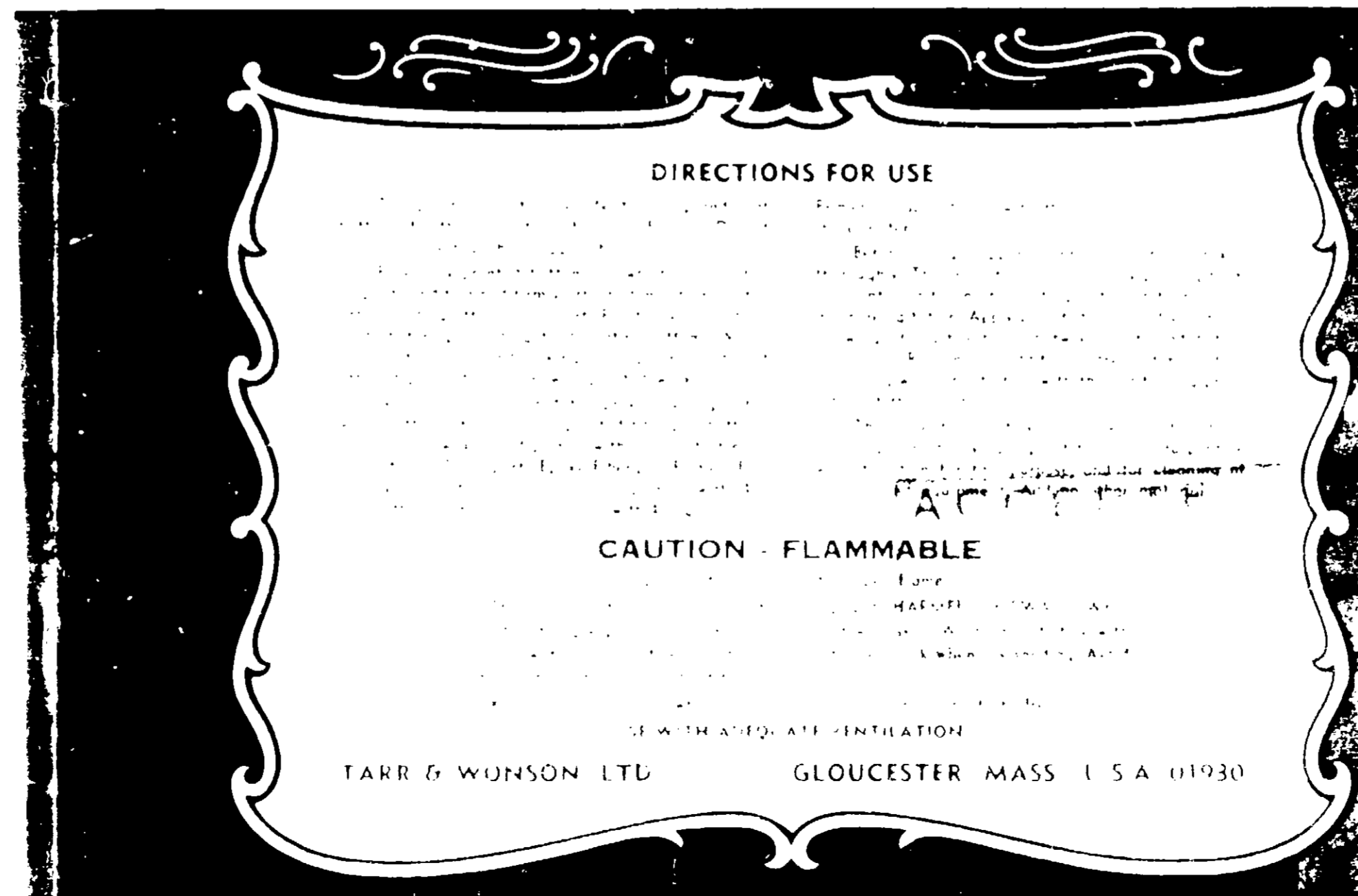
