The amendment referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes below.

1. Revise your storage and disposal statement to read as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Paint that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to federal, state or local procedures under the Resources Conservation and Recovery Act.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Dispose of container by triple rinse and recycling or puncturing and disposing in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures.

The heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" must be of the same type size as the child hazard warning statement.

(For plastic containers include the statement "If burned, stay out of smoke").

2. Delete the phrase "Tin Free" from the label, this is an implied safety claim.

3. The child hazard warning statement on the front panel is the wrong type size. Refer to the enclosure "The Label" for labeling type size requirements. Please note that the minimum type size for labels is 6 points.

4. Change the phrase "Practical Treatment" to "Statement of Practical Treatment". Also print this heading in the same bold lettering as the other headings.

5. Move the "Note" section so that it directly follows the Precautionary Statements section, and appears before the Statement of Practical Treatment section.

6. Revise the sentence "If swallowed,...quantities of water" to read "If swallowed, promptly drink large quantities of water."

Steel: Bring new steel to bright finish and prime with two coats of **MS-200 Epoxy Resin Lead primer**. On previously painted surfaces, remove or flaking spots in the old coating should be cleaned down to bright

metal by wire brushing, power sanding or sandblasting and immediately spot-primed. At least one additional coat of primer should be applied to these spots before finish-coating.
