

**FEED INGREDIENTS**  
Dicalcium Phosphate, Monosodium Phosphate, Monoammonium Phosphate, Calcium Carbonate, Manganous Oxide, Iron Sulfate, Zinc Oxide, Copper Oxide, Cobalt Carbonate, Magnesium Oxide, Iron Oxide, Sodium Selenite, Ethylene Diamine Dihydrochloride, Vitamin A Supplement, Vitamin D3 Supplement, Taurin Sulfonate, Ground Grain Products, Cane Molasses, Natural and Artificial Flavors added.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
**GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**  
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Feed H10-17N Mineral at the rate of one ounce per 750 pounds of body weight per head per day by mixing it into the ground grain or complete daily ration.

Start feeding H10-17N Mineral early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding throughout the summer into the fall until cold weather restricts fly activity.

H10-17N Mineral may be fed up to slaughter and to lactating dairy cows.

H10-17N Mineral prevents the development of horn flies, face flies, house flies and stable flies in the manure of treated cattle but is not effective against existing adult flies. When starting a feeding program during the fly season, it is desirable to use other control measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies.

In some areas supplemental fly control measures may be needed in and around cattle lots and pastures to control adult house flies and stable flies which can breed in cattle manure but in other areas the vegetable matter or sludge on the premises.

In order to achieve optimum fly control, H10-17N Mineral should be used in conjunction with proper management and sanitation practices.
