Dear Ms. Aal:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you revise the label as indicated below.

1. The "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" block requires the insertion of the following statement as the first sentence in this section: "Harmful if absorbed through skin."
2. The "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" block must include the following as the final sentence in this block: "Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treatment areas."
3. Under the section "Warranty" replace the statement beginning with: "Buyer assumes all responsibility for safety..." to read: "To the extent permitted by law user or buyer assumes all responsibility for safety. use and disposal, not in accordance with directions. As currently written the statement negates and/or detracts from labeling requirements as set forth by the Agency in the 40 CFR Part 156, and is, therefore, considered misbranding."



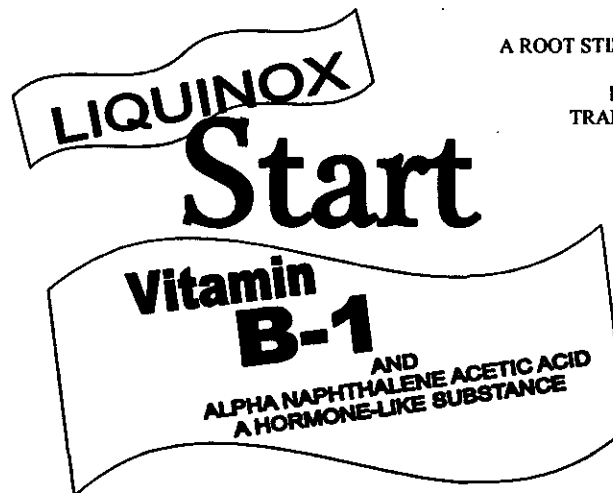
