USE RESTRICTIONS: This bait is to be used only for the control of the plains pocket gopher (*Geomys bursarius*) and the northern pocket gopher (*Thomomys talpoides*) with a mechanical burrow builder or with a mechanical hand probe. DO NOT PLACE BAIT ON OR ABOVE THE GROUND SURFACE.

Baiting Artificial Burrow Builder Method: Follow manufacturer's instructions for the equipment used to apply gopher bait. Apply 1 to 2 pounds of bait using a 20 to 30 foot row spacing intervals. Apply only when soil condition is proper to insure formation of a good artificial burrow.

FOR POCKET GOPHERS:

HAND APPLICATIONS: To locate underground runways, use an iron bar or a broomstick and probe 6 to 12 inches away from planned side of the fan-shaped earth mound. When resistance on probe decreases, probe is in a main runway. Insert 1 tablespoon of bait through probe hole and cover opening securely with a piece of soil. Do not permit dirt to sift in and cover bait. Bait may also be applied by opening newly formed mounds by carefully removing dirt plugs and using a long handled spoon to insert 1 tablespoon of bait at the point where the lateral tunnel to the mound joins the main tunnel. One pound of bait will treat 1 to 6 acres, depending upon the number of pocket gopher burrow systems present.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, feed, or food by storage or disposal.

Store in the original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to children, pets, and domestic animals. Care must be taken so bags are not torn or broken. In the event of a damaged bag, clean up the spilled grain and dispose properly, and repair bag with heavy tape.

DISPOSAL:
