This product is toxic to wildlife. This product is toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment. Do not apply this product while bees are actively visiting the treated area. ## SUBTERRANEAN TERMITES (OUTDOORS on/around buildings and perimeters within 3 feet of the structure))

This product will kill workers and /or winged reproductive forms of termites present at the time of application only. Application of this product will not provide structural protection nor substitute for mechanical alteration, soil or foundation treatment with termiticide. This product is not to be used as sole protection against termites, as it is not intended for use for elimination of termite infestations nor for protection against future infestations. A professional inspection is recommended.

A complete termite barrier may require treatment with another EPA registered product to the inside perimeter of the foundation and to other interior critical areas. For these situations contact a licensed pest control operator for treatment. DO NOT use under slabs, in crawl spaces or indoors. If termites are found within the house or structure, contact a licensed pest control operator for treatment.

### MIXING INSTRUCTIONS for Termites AMOUNT TO USE

#### When using a tank sprayer

One packet per 2 gallons of water to be sprayed over 334 sq. ft. Do not split or open individual packets. Entire packet must be used.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

Apply as a pinstream, spot, or crack and crevice spray on the outside of buildings, porches, wooden decks and patios, wooden fences around buildings, window frames, doorways, foundations, eaves, patios, garages, and other building areas outdoors where you may find these pests.

WHEN TO REAPPLY Repeat application is necessary only if there are signs of renewed insect activity. Repeat application should be limited to no more than once per fourteen days.

#### **IMPORTANT**

DO NOT treat structures that contain cisterns, wells, french drains or sump systems. Soil in the vicinity of wells, cisterns or ponds should not be treated. For those situations, contact your County Cooperative Extension Agent or consult a commercial pest control service. DO NOT treat soil that is water saturated or frozen, or in any conditions where run-off or movement from the treatment area (site) is likely to occur. DO NOT apply while it is raining. DO NOT use on pets. DO NOT use on edible or ornamental plants or lawns. Spray drift onto these plants should be rinsed off immediately with water.

## HOME INVADING PESTS (OUTDOORS on/around buildings and perimeters within 3 feet of the structure)

Ants (excluding red imported fire ants, harvester ants, pharoah ants, and carpenter ants), beetles, boxelder bugs, crickets, earwigs, elm leaf beetles, firebrats, flies (common vinegar flies (Drosophila spp.), Phorid flies, cluster flies, Sphaerocerid flies, flesh flies, and bottle flies), millipedes, silverfish, springtails, sow-bugs (pillbugs).

Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Aim spray at nest openings in ground, and in cracks and crevices which may harbor nests, saturating nest openings and contacting as many insects as possible.

#### **AMOUNT TO USE**

#### When using a tank sprayer

One packet per 2 gallons of water to be sprayed over 334 sq. ft. Do not split or open individual packets. Entire packet must be used.

#### When using the Ortho Dial 'N Spray'

- 1. Set dial to 0:5 fl oz.
- Fill with water. Add 3 packets to sprayer jar and shake until dissolved.
- 3. Spray evenly over 1,000 sq. ft. until jar is empty.

#### PERIMETER TREATMENT

To keep insects from entering the house, use a hoseend or tank sprayer to spray a 3 foot band of soil around the house next to the foundation. Also spray the foundation of the house to a height of 2 to 3 feet. House siding may be treated if pests such as ants (excluding red imported fire ants, harvester ants, pharoah ants, and carpenter ants), boxelder bugs, crickets, earwigs, elm leaf beetles, firebrats, flies (common vinegar flies (Drosophila spp.), Phorid flies, cluster flies, Sphaerocerid flies, flesh flies, and bottle flies) millipedes, silverfish, sowbugs (pillbugs) are present. Close doors and windows prior to treatment.

## MIXING INSTRUCTIONS for Perimeter Treatment AMOUNT TO USE

When using a tank sprayer

One packet per 2 gallons of water to be sprayed over 334 sq. ft. Do not split or open individual packets. Entire packet must beused.

#### When using the Ortho Dial 'N Spray

- 1. Set dial to 0.5 fl oz.
- Fill with water. Add 3 packets to sprayer jar and shake until dissolved.
- 3. Spray evenly over 1,000 sq. ft. until jar is empty.
