Gel should be placed as spots or beads (see use box on next page). Gel can be placed in cracks, crevices, and corners. Inspect gel after 7 days and reapply if it is no longer visible. Refresh with a new application after 3 months. If appropriate, gel should be placed on a small index card for easy removal. Recap tube after use. Gel should not be visible on vertical surfaces; it may drip if exposed to heat.

Severe or heavy infestations for German or Brown-Banded cockroaches: Or Large cockroaches such as American, Smokey-Brown or Oriental:	2-4 spots about the size of the gel syringe cap or 3"-6" bead

Indoors for cockroach control: Place gel where cockroaches are numerous (under sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets). Particular attention should be given to treating entry points and harborage areas. Place the applicator tip into cracks, crevices, voids, holes and other small openings where insects may hide. Apply small amounts of bait (up to 1/2 gram/spot) or as a bead or film at insect activity sites. Cleaning of all areas prior to use of this product will increase levels of control. Any foodstuffs infested with insect pests should be removed and destroyed. Applications to furniture should be restricted to those areas where contact to humans will not occur. Applications to textiles or fabrics may cause discoloration or staining.

Outdoors for cockroach control: Place gel where cockroaches have been seen and where they hide adjacent to structures. Cockroaches infest warm, dark, damp locations. Apply this product as a spot, bead or thin film to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, door and window openings, crawl spaces, air conditioning units, utility entrances through outside walls, under siding/molding, in garages and other adjacent areas where pests have been seen or found. To help prevent infestation, treat areas adjacent to structures where pests may be active and may find nesting sites or harborage. Applications should be made to substrates adjacent to buildings, the building foundations, wall voids, attic and soffit vents, expansion joints, around doors and windows, soffit areas, eaves, under stairways, around screens, on fences, trees and other areas conducive to infestation. Do not apply this product to areas that have been recently sprayed with insecticides, and do not spray insecticides over gel, as it may cause the bait to become repellent.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
