- 3. Submit one year Storage Stability data (830.6317) within 18 months from the date of this registration.
- 4. Make the following changes to the label:
  - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 8033-97".
  - b. Delete "other nuisance ants" and "will eliminate" must be replaced by "will control" wherever they appear on the label.
  - c. For acute toxicity category IV, no Precautionary/First Aid statements are required (optional statements) but the "Harmful if swallowed or adsorbed through the skin" and wash after handling" statements (already on the label) are recommended.

Place gel as spots in cracks and crevices in areas where ants are seen or suspected to be active. Bait should be checked weekly and reapplied when necessary.

#### **What It Controls**

Sweet- and grease-eating ants:

Acrobat, Argentine, big-headed, carpenter, cornfield, crazy, field, ghost, honey, little black, odorous house, pavement, pharaoh, pyramid, rove, thief, velvety tree, and other nuisance ants.

**How to Apply** 

Gel should be placed as spots in cracks and crevices. Make many spots or dabs of gel where you see ants foraging and entering structure. Do not place gel in direct sunlight. Gel should not be visible on vertical surfaces; it may drip if exposed to heat.

Recommended spot size (1/4-1/2 gram)



Indoors for ant control: Place gel in cracks and crevices in areas where ants are seen or suspected to be active (such as, under sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, wall voids, cracks and crevices in kitchen, bathroom, under sink, window sills, screen vents, garage, attic, and crawl spaces). Do not place bait in locations that are frequently washed. Do not treat food preparation surfaces. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment where possibility of a shock hazard exists. Product may stain textiles and clothing.

Outdoors for ant control: Place spots near ant colonies and along trails near structures. (For carpenter ant colonies, locate nests and apply gel spots near associated trails.) This bait may be used adjacent to homes, cabins, stores, apartment buildings, restaurants, trailers, and warehouses. Other likely locations for ants and gel placements are points of entry into structure and areas with potential water damage including: eaves, soffits, weep holes, where wires and pipes come into the building structure, trees, stumps, roots, wood decks, fences, planter boxes, woodpiles, landscaping, and railroad ties.
