Dear Ms. Knox:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.


Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance

F7180-8 Fly Sticker Insecticide - PMP is to be used in and around the perimeter of residential properties, commercial kitchens, trash areas, food storage areas, food/feed handling establishments, cafeterias, canneries, dairies, beverage plants, breweries, food processing plants, hospitals and nursing homes, office buildings, factories, workshops, laboratories, warehouses, stores, shops & retail establishments, supermarkets, hotels, motels, garages, basements, porches, patios & lanais, utility rooms, storage sheds, schools, gymnasias, recreational facilities, locker rooms, lavatories, transportation equipment (buses, cargo trucks, trailers, trains), agricultural buildings, commercial and residential areas used for housing, boarding, and/or rearing animals; barns, stables, paddock fences, fences encircling grazing areas, light poles, feed lots, and poultry houses.

F7180-8 Fly Sticker Insecticide - PMP kills flies that land on the sticker surface and ingest the sticker coating. Stickers work best when placed on or near a window or other light source. However, in the absence of light or under low-light conditions, place stickers near a potential fly food source (such as inside a garbage can) or where flies are seen to congregate. Check sticker effectiveness every 3 months. Replace stickers as needed. Variations in environmental conditions (such as temperature, humidity, air-borne dust, grease and other contaminants) and pest pressure can affect the amount of time before the sticker needs to be replaced. Check effectiveness of F7180-8 Fly Sticker Insecticide - PMP by observation of dead flies and reduced fly population in treated area.

The number of stickers to use is based on the size of the area where flies are found. Apply one sticker per 1000 cubic feet. Use up to 5 stickers per 1,000 cubic feet for heavy infestations. In rooms with high infestations, or for quicker results, place a sticker in each window. Keep stickers dry after application.

Restrictions:

- Do not use on sky lights.
- Do not allow children to handle stickers or let pets come in contact with them.
- Do not place stickers directly above areas where food is stored, prepared or eaten.
- In animal facilities, livestock premises, do not place stickers where animals, children or pets may come into contact with them.
- Do not put stickers on animals, food and watering equipment, or milking equipment.

Use Information:

F7180-8 Fly Sticker Insecticide - PMP is used to kill the following filth flies: house flies, little house flies, blow flies, bottle flies, flesh flies, phorid flies, fungus gnats, and vinegar (fruit) flies. [No fumes or vapors are released.] The coating on each sticker is attractive to flies. Flies ingest the coating and start to die within one minute. Dead flies do not stick to the surface. Remove dead flies with a brush or broom and dispose in trash, or by vacuuming. If a catch basin is used, remove dead flies on a routine basis.

Place stickers on windows, near light sources or other places, areas or surfaces where flies

congregate. Keep out of reach of children and pets. If flies are congregating around bait stations and fly light traps, place stickers on those items. If flies are congregating in commercial trash areas, kitchens and food storage areas place stickers in those areas. Place stickers in areas so that they avoid becoming wet.

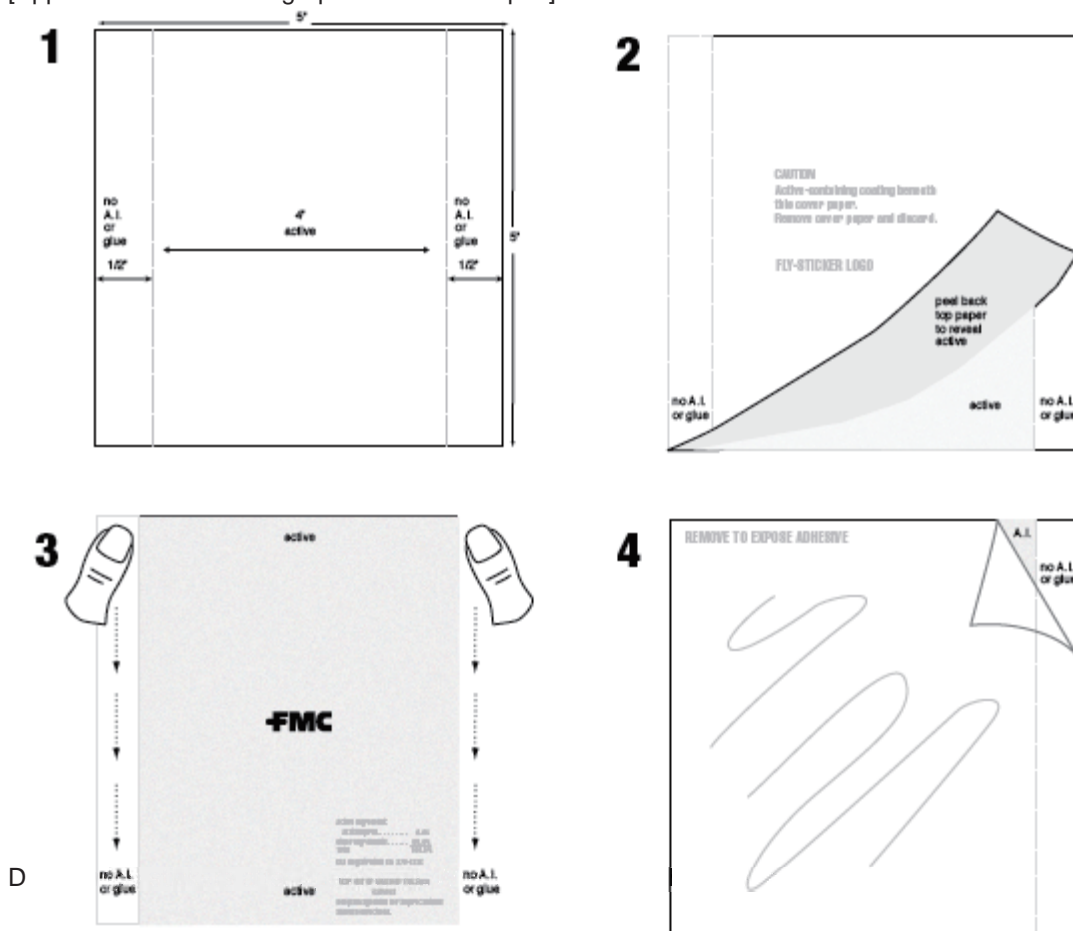
In animal facilities, place stickers on walls, windows, and structural supports. Place stickers near manure piles and feeding troughs. Do not put stickers on animals, food and watering equipment, or milking equipment. Place sticker lower to the ground as flies tend to feed in those areas. Stickers must be placed so that animals, children and pets cannot come into contact with them.

Applying stickers:

Stickers have an adhesive coating on one side and a [paper][plastic] cover on the other.

With dry hands remove cover from the adhesive coating side first. Place sticker in desired location. Once sticker is adhered, remove the [paper][plastic] cover to expose the attractive coating.
