DISINFECTING WASH.	1 oz per 2 gallons of water (200 ppm available chlorine)	Meets requirements of U S Public Health Service for disinfecting thoroughly cleansed and rinsed surfaces such as glasses, dishes, and food utensils in Restaurants Taverns, Soda Fountains, and Dairies
LAUNDERING: To bleach white and color fast cottons, linens, white nylons, synthetics, in washing machine, automatic washer or tub. Do not use on silk, wool, leather or sponge	1 tablespoon to each gallon of water or 1 cup to the ordinary washing machine load of 16 gallons. For slightly soiled clothes use less	WASHING MACHINES: Add to first rinse or to suds. Rinse well. AUTOMATICS: Add to either suds or pre soak. If unable to add before clothes are in machine dilute in 1 quart of water before using
TO WHITEN nylon, synthetics, that have turned yellow or gray	Make solution of 2 tablespoons bleach, 1 teaspoon of vinegar, warm water	Put clean fabric into solution for 15 to 30 minutes. Rinse well. Repeat if necessary
TO REMOVE STAINS: fruit, berry, wine, coffee, tea, ink, dye and medicine stains, also SCRUBB & MILDEW.	Make solution of 2 tablespoons to each quart of cold water	Immerse fabric for 5 to 10 minutes—Rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary
IN KITCHEN & BATHROOM: on tile, porcelain, linoleum, enameled surfaces	Use 1 cupful to pail of warm water	Wash, rinse and dry
REFRIGERATORS.	Use 3 tablespoons to quart of warm water	Thoroughly wash inside surface and shelves. Keep wet with solution for 5 minutes. Rinse well, dry and air
SICK ROOM.	3 tablespoons into each quart of warm water.	Urinals, sputum cups, rubber sheets, bedpans—wash thoroughly, immerse or keep wet in solution for 5 minutes, rinse dry
DRINKING WATER.	10 drops to a gallon of water	Mix well—let stand for 5 minutes
DEODORIZING— Baby clothes and diapers, dish cloths, handkerchiefs	3 tablespoons to 1 quart of cold or lukewarm water	First wash, then dip in solution for 5 minutes. Rinse well
TO DEODORIZE DRAINPIPES.	Cupful	Flush with boiling water and follow up with cupful of bleach
GARBAGE CANS.	3 tablespoons to each quart warm water	Wash in hot suds, rinse, then wash with solution. Keep wet for 5 to 10 minutes, rinse and dry
TOILET BOWLS.	1/2 cup	Cleanse and flush, then add 1/2 cup solution over inside surface and let stand over night

USE ON WHITE OR FAST COLOR COTTONS, LINENS AND SYNTHETICS; DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL, LEATHER, SPONGE, ACETATE OR SPANDEX.

CAUTION—Harmful if swallowed. If splashed in eyes—Flush with water. If splashed on skin—rinse off with water. If swallowed—feed milk—Call Physician. Do not mix with toilet bowl cleaners or acids as toxic fumes may develop.

TEST FOR BLEACHABILITY

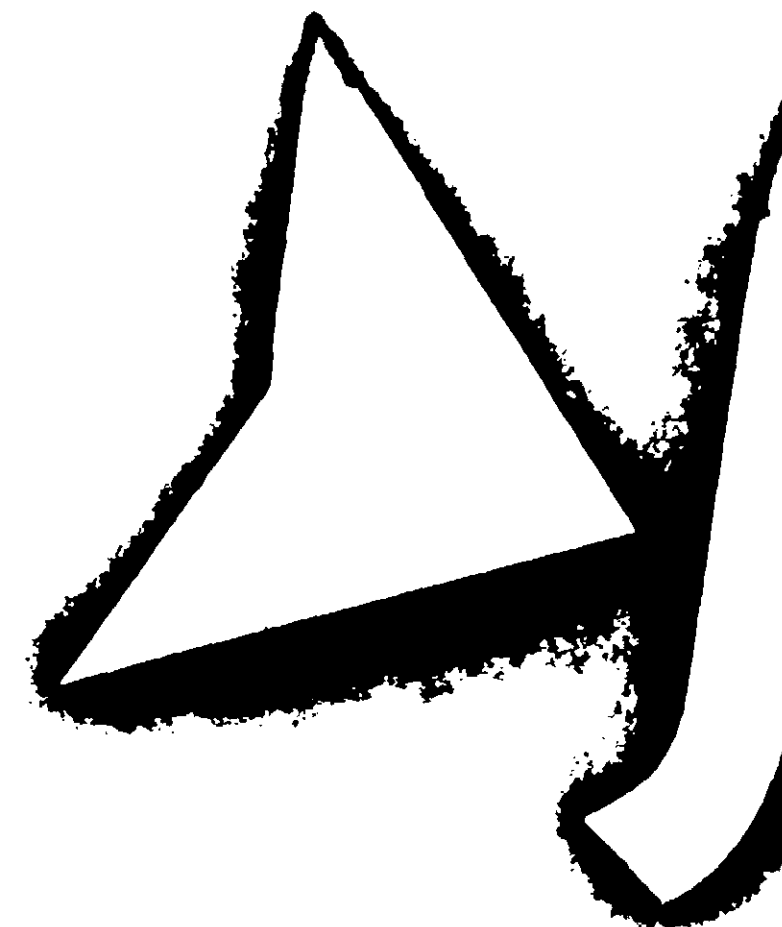
To test a colored fabric, wash and wear cottons and rayons, or a fabric of unknown composition for bleachability, apply a mixture of 1 tablespoon of bleach in a gallon of hot water to an inconspicuous corner and let stand for 35 minutes. If fabric color fades or yellows, it is not bleachable.
