

#### HOW CADCO KLEEN WORKS

CADCO KLEEN is a concentrated, balanced formulation containing a positive deodorizer, non-ionic detergent and builders. This combination makes CADCO KLEEN a most efficient product for cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing in one labor-saving operation.

#### WHERE TO USE

CADCO KLEEN should be used at regular intervals to thoroughly clean, deodorize, sanitize and disinfect floors, lavatories, exterior toilet bowl surfaces, urinals, walls, telephones, garbage pails, refrigerators, diaper pails, shower stalls, venetian blinds, hog houses, poultry nouses, hog troughs, watering tanks, poultry equipment, dairy equipment, out buildings, sprayers, tanks, truck bodies, hog feeders.

For general cleaning and sanitizing of hard surfaces, use 1 oz. of Cadco Kleen per gallon of water (250 ppm active quaternary), and thoroughly scrub. For cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing hard surfaces, use 2 oz. of Cadco Kleen per gallon of water (500 ppm active quaternary) and thoroughly scrub. Where infectious disease germs may be present, rinse all surfaces and repeat as above.

**Preparing Areas For Cleaning:** Remove animals. litter, manure, equipment and feedstuffs from floors, walls, pens, stalls, chutes, troughs, racks, and other facilities occupied or traversed by animals, empty all watering appliances. Ventilate buildings, cars, boats, and other

closed spaces.

Cleaning: Saturate all hard surfaces with Cadco Kleen and scrub thoroughly, immerse all halters, ropes, and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovers, and scrapers. Reuse: Do not house livestock or employ equipment until the treatment has dried. All treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains, waterers and all surfaces that are likely to come in contact with food, must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

Cadco Kleen is a concentrated product, and should be diluted before using. Do not allow it to come in contact with food. It should not be mixed with soap or other anionic detergents which are incompatible.


