

MAY BE USED ON WHITE 100% NYLON, ORLON, DACRON, THE SAME AS ON WHITE COTTON AND LINEN.

PURPOSE	AMOUNT	DIRECTIONS
Disinfectant, Deodorizer or Stain Remover: In kitchen, bath, sickroom, refrigerator, sink, tie, dish cloths, garbage cans, wood utensils, tubs, showers.	3 tablespoons K-O-K to each quart warm water.	Wash. Immerse, or keep wet for 5 minutes using bleach solution. Rinse. For dishes, coffee pots, tea pots, glassware, fruit jars, thermos bottles, plastic use 1 tablespoon bleach.
TOILET BOWLS: (Do not use Toilet bowl cleaners in combination with bleach)	1/2 cup K-O-K	Cleanse bowl, flush. Add bleach, swish inside. Let stand hour. Flush.
SWIMMING POOLS: To make the water hygienically cleaner. (Will not harm plastic pools.)	28 oz. (3-1/2 cups) K-O-K to each 10,000 gallons of new water. Test water frequently and add Bleach as required to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 P. P. M. Available Chlorine.	Thoroughly mix Bleach in 20 parts water and feed solution through a chlorinator, or dilute and scatter over surface of pool.
Restaurants, Taverns, Soda Fountains, Dairies, Farm Equipment: For disinfecting after cleaning surfaces	1 tablespoon K-O-K per each gallon of water.	Wash clean. Place in solution or keep wet 2 minutes. Makes solution of 200 parts per million available chlorine.
