



*SPECIAL SITUATIONS

If slugs, snails, and other listed insects are invading from adjacent properties, a pencil-thin line the entire length of the infested area will form a barrier and result in excellent control.

*CORRY'S SLUG, SNAIL & INSECT KILLER can be used to protect home ornamental plants, flower gardens, dichondra and home turf lawns, and fruit and vegetable plants. When protecting fruit and vegetable plants treat area around plants and between rows. Do not apply to foliage or edible parts of plant. 


