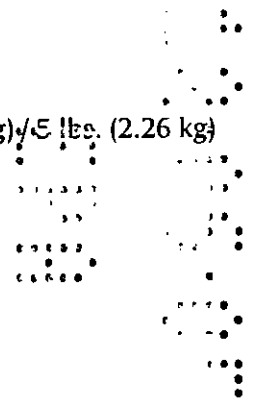

Easy to use, quick and economical **CORRY'S SLUG, SNAIL & INSECT KILLER** resists rain and sprinkling and remains effective in the garden for many days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Wearing chemical resistant gloves, such as polyethylene or butyl rubber or neoprene rubber or viton, apply product directly from original container on soil in area to be treated. Apply when air is calm to avoid drift and contact with eyes and skin. Start applying at the farthest corner of the treatment area and work backward to avoid contact with dusted surfaces. Allow dust to settle in treated areas before reentering. Do not repeat application more than once every seven days. Do not apply product more than four times per season. Days from product application to harvest noted below in parenthesis under **SPECIAL SITUATIONS**.

TO APPLY

Scatter bait lightly on soil in area to be treated. Apply heavier if infestation is severe. This product is for use in home and garden areas. This bait is extremely attractive to slugs, snails, and other listed insects and will lure them from their hiding places. All likely places should be treated as slugs, snails and other listed insects travel. They favor damp, well shaded locations where they can obtain shelter by day. Be sure area to be treated is damp. In dry weather, water well before applying bait. Preferred baiting time is in the evening as these pests feed mainly at night. Normally apply bait every two weeks until infestation is under control. Heavy or prolonged rain can shorten effective period of bait. Use more frequently under these conditions. Use approximately one pound per 1750 square feet. Plants noted below with * use approximately one pound per 2200 square feet.

⁺For mole crickets, water-in thoroughly (¼ to ½ inch of water) following application to move the insecticide into the root zone.

***SPECIAL SITUATIONS**

If slugs, snails, and other listed insects are invading from adjacent properties, a pencil-thin line the entire length of the infested area will form a barrier and result in excellent control.

***CORRY'S SLUG, SNAIL & INSECT KILLER** can be used to protect home ornamental plants, flower gardens, dichondra and home turf lawns, and fruit and vegetable plants. When protecting fruit and vegetable plants treat area around plants between rows. Do not apply to foliage or edible parts of plant. Protect the following fruit and vegetable plants: asparagus (1), beans (3), cabbage (3), carrots (7), celery (15), *cucumbers (3), lettuce (15), *melons (3), peas (3), peppers (3), potatoes (7), radishes (7), spinach (15), *squash (3), tomatoes (3), turnips (7), and strawberries (7).

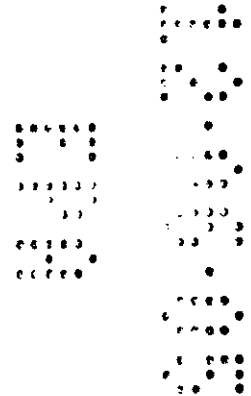



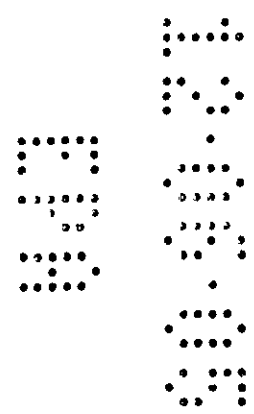
