Apply this product in areas likely to be infested at the beginning of the spring planting season before damage occurs and as needed during periods of damp weather. Treat every 3 to 4 weeks or as needed. During periods of high rainfall or frequent waterings, it may be necessary to treat more often. If ground is dry, thoroughly water areas to be treated. For best results, apply in the evening around flowers, ornamental plants, vegetable gardens and lawn areas. Apply only to the soil surface around plants. Do not apply directly to plants. Do not mix with any seeds prior to application.

Flowers & Lawns: Flip up spout and lightly squeeze a solid line of this product around flower beds and lawn edges. Apply any time, but preferably in early evening. Repeat applications as needed. When applying, occasionally turn bottle upright to allow air to enter bottle. Vegetable Gardens: Apply a solid line on the soil between berry and vegetable plants. Force II Deadline Slug & Snail Killer can be used on the following plants: Ornamentals: azaleas, begonias, camellias, chrysanthemums, daffodiis dahlias, a daisies, geraniums, honeysuckle, hydrangeas, ice plant, impatiens, iris, marigolds, pansies, retennias, rhododendrons, roses, snapdragons, sweet peas, tulips.
