DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is specially formulated to attract and control slugs and snails. The presence of slugs and snails can be detected by their shiny-mucous trail. They are night feeders and prefer damp, cool places. Apply this product in areas likely to be infested at the beginning of the spring planting season before damage occurs and as needed during periods of damp weather. Treat every 3 to 4 weeks during the growing season or as needed. During periods of high rainfall or frequent waterings, it may be necessary to treat more often. If ground is dry, thoroughly water areas to be treated. For best results, apply in the evening around flowers, ornamental plants, vegetable gardens and lawn areas. Do not place pellets in piles. Apply only to the soil surface around plants. Do not apply directly to plants. Do not mix with any seed prior to application.

FLOWERS & LAWNS: Pull tab to open and scatter RainTough® Deadline® Slug & Snail Killer pellets around flower beds and lawn edges. Apply any time, but preferably in early evening. Repeat applications as needed.

VEGETABLE GARDENS: Scatter RainTough® Deadline® Slug & Snail Killer pellets on soil around berry and vegetable plants.

ORNAMENTALS: azaleas, begonias, camellias, chrysanthemums, daffodils, dahlias, daisies, geraniums, honeysuckle, hydrangeas, ice plant, impatiens, iris, marigolds, pansies, patunias, rhododendrons, roses, snapdragons, sweet peas, tulips.

VEGETABLES: beans, beets, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cantaloupe, carrots, cauliflower, celery, corn, cucumbers, garlic, horseradish, lettuce, melons, onions, peas, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, squash, Swiss chard, tomatoes.

FIRST AID
