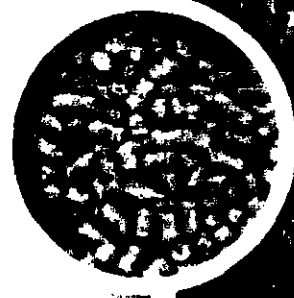

Slugs and snails are two of our most destructive garden pests. Although their outward appearance is quite different, they are essentially the same creature, except that the slug does not have the external shell of the snail. Slugs and snails feed almost entirely at night, in the evening or during dark days. They prefer moist, warm conditions and rarely venture from their hiding places during cold weather or during exceedingly dry or hot spells. Slugs and snails hatch from eggs, laid in clusters, under debris, stones or compost heaps or beneath the surface of the soil. Generally, they will hatch out after 20 to 30 days of favorable weather conditions after which time they will continue to grow slowly, eating our most tender and succulent vegetables.

While these small slugs and snails are growing and eating, they migrate toward better feeding and sheltering conditions. It is because of this migrating habit that it is impossible to completely eliminate the slug and snail problem. However, with the use of Vigoro® Snail & Slug Killer Pellets, and a consistent baiting program, these pests can be reduced to where they no longer present a major threat to our gardens.

Apply heavier if infestation is severe. This bait is extremely attractive to slugs and snails and actually lures them from their hiding places and kills them. Reapply bait every 2 weeks - more often during heavy infestations or in areas heavily watered. All likely places should be treated as these pests migrate. They favor damp places around vegetable plants, flower gardens, rockeries, hedges, compost heaps, ditchside lawns, ivy patches and other ground cover where they can obtain shelter by day. For best results, be sure area to be baited is damp. In very dry weather, water well before baiting. Use approximately 1 pound per 2,000 to 4,400 sq ft depending on severity of slug and snail infestation.

This product can be used to protect the following fruit and vegetable plants. Apply only to the soil surface. Do not apply to the foliage or edible parts of the plant. AUTO Primero lea la etiqueta. Observe todas las precauciones y siga las instrucciones cuidadosamente.

Los caracoles y las babosas son dos de las plagas más destructivas de los jardines. Aunque su apariencia exterior es bastante diferente, son básicamente la misma criatura, sólo que la babosa no tiene el caparazón exterior del caracol.

Las babosas y los caracoles se alimentan casi siempre durante la noche, al atardecer o durante los días nublados. Prefieren los lugares húmedos y cálidos y por lo general no salen de sus escondites cuando el clima es frío o durante períodos excesivamente secos o calurosos.

Las babosas y los caracoles se reproducen por medio de huevos que ponen en grupos debajo de escobras, piedras o montones de abono o debajo de la superficie del suelo. Generalmente, nacen después de 20 a 30 días de condiciones climáticas favorables y después continúan creciendo lentamente, comiendo nuestra vegetación más tierna y succulenta.

A medida que estos pequeños babosas y caracoles crecen y comen, migran hacia mejores condiciones de alimentación y refugio. Es este hábito de migrar el que hace imposible eliminar por completo el problema de las babosas y los caracoles.
