1. Delete the statement "Harmful if absorbed through skin." Review the statement "May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled" to read "Harmful if swallowed."
2. Under the "Statement of Practical Treatment" - If swallowed - rephrase to read as follows: If swallowed: Drink promptly a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention.
