

Precautionary Statements

DANGER

Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

Corrosive. Causes skin burns and eye irritation. Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get on skin, clothing or in eyes. May be a dermal sensitizer. Wear a face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wear protective clothing, such as long sleeved cotton shirt, long pants and hat. Use in a well ventilated area. When used in confined areas or applied by spraying, wear protective clothing and a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR 11. May be fatal if swallowed. If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution or water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist.

Practical Treatment

In case of skin contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water. Get medical attention. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If inhaled, remove to fresh air. Use artificial respiration if breathing has stopped. Get medical attention. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. This product contains petroleum distillates. Get medical attention. If in eyes, immediately flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

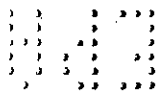
Environmental Hazards

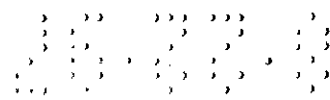

Directions for Use

Devoe Antifouling Paint is suitable for steel, aluminum, and fiberglass. Surface to be coated should be free of moisture. Do not apply with brush or roller. For spraying, approved respiratory goggles should be used. Solvent. Launching dry, or later if desired.

Storage and Disposal
