

SOFT-N-STAT is based on a highly active mixture of three *Twin Chain* quaternary ammonium compounds together with an effective fabric softener.

Soiled and contaminated fabrics such as diapers, hospital and institutional linen and athletic equipment is a major housekeeping problem not only in hospitals but in institutions, hotels, restaurants and schools. Used as directed SOFT-N-STAT imparts an effective residual bacteriostatic treatment together with softening to laundered items such as diapers, hospital and institutional linens and athletic apparel. This finish will effectively protect the fabric against rapid bacterial growth caused by moisture and wet contamination.

SOFT-N-STAT is designed for commercial and institutional laundry use by addition to the final rinse. Laundered fabric may also be treated and softened by soaking in a solution of SOFT-N-STAT. For recommended solution concentration, see "Use Directions".

SOFT-N-STAT Bacteriostatic Laundry Softener Concentrate is economical to use because it is concentrated. It should be handled with care.


