DIRECTIONS

This pine oil disinfectant is for use in schools, hotels, motels, jails and all types of commercial buildings. It may be used on any hard surface, such as floors, walls, woodwork or ceilings, where disinfection and deodorizing are desired.

Before using this disinfectant, heavy soil and dirt should be removed by using any good detergent cleaner.

For all general disinfecting, use one part to 100 parts of water -- approximately one ounce to three quarts of water. Apply this solution so as to thoroughly wet surfaces to be cleaned and disinfected.

Rinse with clear water, after scrubbing. May be used as a scrub solution, or may be sprayed on surfaces.

Steam distilled pine oil and vegetable
oil soap.

INERT INGREDIENT Not more than 10.0%
Water
