LIQUID DUST CONTROL TREATMENT FOR YARN BROOMS-DUST MOPS-DUST CLOTHS.

FOR MOPS:

Dilute solution with equal part of water, and pour into pan large enough to accommodate mop. Soak mop in solution until completely saturated. Wring out excess solution, turn mop upside down, and let dry. Mop is ready to use. Accumulated dust and dirt are easily shaken out of mop. When too soiled for further use, launder and re-treat as above.

Spray mop evenly until strands are slightly moist. Allow mop to dry for at least six hours, or preferably overnight. Do not allow moistened mop to rest on composition tiles, etc. Accumulated dust and dirt are easily shaken out of mop. When too soiled for further use, launder and re-treat as above.
