GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is a specifically formulated non-selective vegetation killer for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. Apply undiluted as a spray on non-cropland areas where bare ground is desired. Control will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall and other conditions. This product is non-corrosive to metal surfaces. Especially compounded for industrial and municipal weed control.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not stack more than five drums high. Drums should be opened in well-ventilated areas. Leaking or damaged drums should be placed in overpack drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. GENERAL WEED CONTROL: To control most weeds on cropland areas such as parking lots, fence rows, utility sidings and storage yards, spray at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons per each 1,000 square feet.

This product may be applied at any time of year, EXCEPT when ground is frozen. Best results are obtained after vegetation has emerged, in late spring or early summer. Use power sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, or an ordinary sprinkling can. No dilution or agitation is required.

Your submission of March 29, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that you:

- 1) Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a) Your source of 2,4-D, Isocetyl ester, registration 6230-139, contains a minimum 2,4-D ester and acid equivalent content of 67.2 and 44.66 respectively (lessor specific method of analysis). Revise your ingredient declarations to 1.0% Isocetyl ester and 0.7% acid equivalent to correspond.
 - b) Refer to 40 CFR 162.10 for proper label format for prescriptive statements, including headings and subheadings. A sample label is enclosed. Under HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS, it will not be necessary to repeat the harmful if swallowed ... and causes skin irritations - statements. Add the subheading ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS above the paragraph beginning - This product is toxic to fish and wildlife In this paragraph, change - Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds - to read - Do not apply directly to water or wetlands.
 - c) Revise the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL statements to be consistent with PR Notice 83-3 (attached). Note that 2,4-D esters are on the RCRA "Y" list. Since this product is for industrial or institutional use only, delete the wording for 1 gallon containers ... wrap container and place in trash collection. That wording is appropriate for consumer products.
