The subject amendments are acceptable. It is understood that the formula statements dated February 2 and 10, 1987 replace previously accepted formulas for these products.

The labeling, reflecting revised formulation information, is acceptable provided you:

1. Make the following changes before releasing the products for shipment bearing amended labeling.
 - a. For EPA Registration No. 8123-70, refer to 40 CFR 162.10 for proper label format, including the general heading "Precautionary Statements" and subheadings "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals," "Environmental Hazards," and "Physical or Chemical Hazards." Group first aid statements, adding practical treatment for swallowing and eye contact.
 - b. Under Environmental Hazards, add "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" for EPA Registration Nos. 8123-23 and 8123-28. Modify "Keep Out of . . ." to read "Do not apply directly to water" for EPA Registration No. 8123-70.

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c. Under "Physical or Chemical Hazards" add "Do not use or store near heat or open flame" for EPA Registration Nos. 8123-23, 8123-29, and 8123-70.

2. Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not stack more than five drums high. Drums should be opened in well-ventilated areas. Leaking or damaged drums should be placed in overpack drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

GENERAL WEED CONTROL: To control most weeds on non-cropland areas such as parking lots, fence rows, railroad sidings and storage yards, spray at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons for each 1,000 square feet.

DIRECTIONS: This product may be applied at any time of the year, EXCEPT when ground is frozen. Best results are obtained after vegetation has emerged, in late spring or early summer. Use power sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, or an ordinary sprinkling can. No dilution or agitation is required.

CAUTION: Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity.

Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.

Avoid drift spray to susceptible plants, as this product may injure cotton, beans, peas, grapes, ornamentals, etc.
