**FOR MOPS:**

Spray mop evenly until strands are  
slightly moist. Allow mop to dry for at  
least six hours, or preferably overnight.  
Do not allow moistened mop to rest on  
composition tiles, etc. Accumulated  
dust and dirt are easily shaken out of  
mop. When too soiled for further use,  
launder and re-treat as above.
