The proposed container and pesticide storage and disposal instructions are in compliance with FR Notice 83-3 and are acceptable.

Please note, for the smaller size containers (1 qt. through 1 gallon) you may use the following disposal instructions.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly and discard in trash.

However, we have no objections if you intend to use the proposed instructions for all sizes.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

At the next printing of the label, on the right panel above the 3rd paragraph, insert the heading:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store pesticide in a locked area, away from access by children. Store in original container only. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL - Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL - Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

For sanitizing and disinfecting floors, walls and inanimate hard surfaces. For Schools, Homes, Locker Rooms, Garbage Pails, Sink Tops, Corridors, Classrooms, Offices and Shower Stalls. After a thorough precleaning of the surface; apply solution with mop or cloth. Then wipe, mop or scrub so as to thoroughly wet the surface with the sanitizing solution. Sanitize with 1 ounce Concentrate to 4 gallons of water. Disinfectant with 3 oz. of Concentrate to 5 gallons of water. Kills Staphylococcus aureus and Salmonella choleraesuis.

HOSPITALS

For floors, walls and other hard surfaces. In Nursing Homes, Institutions, as well as Sink Tops, Garbage Pails, Telephones and Restrooms. After a thorough precleaning of the surface, apply a solution of the Concentrate at 3 1/2 ounces per 5 gallons of water. Then wipe, mop or scrub so as to thoroughly wet the surface with sanitizing solution. At this level the Concentrate will be effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10.

FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT

For sanitization of food processing equipment and food utensils, after thoroughly cleaning and rinsing equipment, dilute 1 ounce of Concentrate per 4 gallons of water to provide 200 ppm of active quaternary. Then wipe or scrub with the sanitizing solution so as to wet the surfaces thoroughly. At this level, no potable water rinse is required.

DAIRIES

To sanitize dairy equipment, first clean and rinse the equipment thoroughly. Then apply sanitizing solution containing 1 oz. of Concentrate to 4 gallons of water (200 ppm), by wiping or scrubbing the equipment with the solution so as to wet the surfaces thoroughly. At this level, no potable water rinse is required. Follow recommendations of local Health Board.

COLD DISINFECTION

For disinfection of instruments, barber tools submerge instruments of concentrate per gallon

RESTAURANT & BAR

Dishes, glassware, silver with soap or synthetic immerse in a sanitizing concentrate to 4 gallons water rinse required.
