DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsiste, with its labelling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store pesticide in a locked area, away from access by children. Store in original container only. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not reuse empty container.

For sanitization of food processing equipment and food utensils, after thoroughly cleaning and rinsing equipment, dilute 1 ounce of Concentrate per 4 gallons of water to provide 200 ppm of active quaternary. Then wipe or scrib with the sanitizing solution so as to wet the surfaces thoroughly. At this level, no potable water rinse is required.

DAIRIES

To sanitize dairy equipment, first clean and rinse the equipment thoroughly. Then apply sanitizing solution containing 1 oz. of Concentrate to 4 gallons of water (200 ppm), by wiping or scrubbing the equipment with the solution so as to wet the surfaces thoroughly. At this level, no potable water rinse is required. Follow recommendations of local Health Board.
