PURPOSE AMOUNT DIRECTIONS

Disinfectant, Deodorizer or Stain Remover: In kitchen, bath, sickroom, refrigerator, sink, tile, dishcloths, garbage cans, wood utensils, tubs, showers.	3 tablespoons K-O-K to each quart warm water.
