Label revisions to update Storage and Disposal and First Aid Statements

#### **Comments:**

Based on a review of the material submitted, the following comments apply:

- 1. Revise the 'If Swallowed' section by adding the word 'immediately' preceding the statement "...for treatment advice."
- 2. Revise the Storage and Disposal Statements as follows:
  - a. Delete the statement "Do not reuse container but place in trash collection." as this statement is redundant.
  - b. Revise the statement "Offer for recycling..." to read "Offer for recycling if available or place in trash collection."

This application for notification to revise the product label, as referenced above, is acceptable. A copy has been placed in our records for future reference.

#### LAUNDERING IN TUB, WASHING MACHINE, OR AUTOMATIC WASHER:
